Directors Announcements

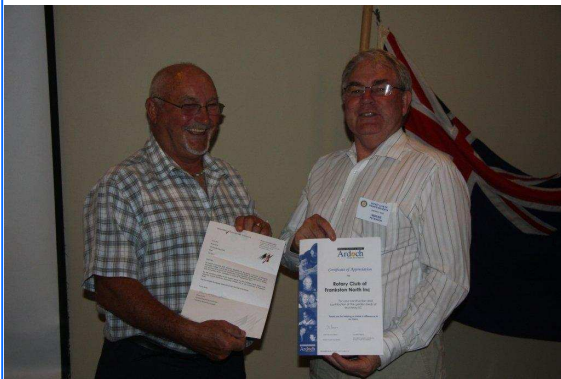
